KELLY, Jeanne Marie - A beloved mother, wife and friend, died today at her Santa Fe home after a brave struggle against cancer. She is survived by her husband, Daniel T. Kelly Jr.; and children: Susan Ellis Kelly of Santa Fe, Thomas Kelly and his wife Carroll Dunham Kelly of Kathmandu, Nepal, Robert Kelly of New York City and Santa Fe, and Pamela Kelly Witt and her husband Steven of San Francisco, California; her sister, Betty Oliver lives in Charleston, South Carolina. Jeanne grew up in Scarsdale, New York, with her parents: Harold and Elizabeth Wise. Her father was Chairman of MacFadden Publications. She attended Rogers Hall in Lowell, Massachusetts, and graduated from Pine Manor Junior College in 1941. Following her graduation, she studied business and secretarial skills in New York City. She was employed by a national advertising company in New York City and later with the same firm in Hollywood, California. While in California, she enlisted in the U.S. Navy Waves. She trained at Hunter College N.Y.C. and was assigned to Pensacola Naval Air Base where she instructed in Free Aerial Gunnery. Following the end of the war, she worked for Owens Corning and later Eastman Dillon Company where she pursued her interest in administration and finance. In 1949, she interrupted her career with a six month sojourn in Santa Fe where she met and fell in love with her future husband. In 1953 she married Daniel T. Kelly and made Santa Fe her home. She was known for her welcoming spirit and warm embrace of newcomers to the community. Jeanne's considerate nature for others expressed itself in her commitment to civic interests. She was a long-time member of the St. Vincent Hospital Auxiliary, the St. Francis Cathedral Parish, the Women's Board of the Museum of New Mexi-

co, the Santa Fe Opera Guild, and many other philanthropic and charitable organizations. Her pragmatic and organizational skills will be sorely missed. To her family she will always be remembered as an ever-thoughtful, sensitive and loving mother who was grounded by her deep spiritual faith. A gracious hostess and efficient organizer, Jeanne was known for her refreshing directness and inquisitive and perceptive nature. An avid tennis player, she enjoyed skiing, walking, dancing and traveling. Visitation will be at the Santuario de Guadalupe from 4:00 to 7:00 Friday, January 22.
