Georgia Beidler Morris, (LCDR, USN, RET) died October 6, 2015 after a long illness. She was born November 13, 1920 in Fort Worth, TX to Jerry D. and Elizabeth Tatum Beidler. Upon Graduating from high school in Trinidad, TX, she entered the nurses training program at Methodist Hospital in Fort Worth. She completed her training just prior to the outbreak of WWII. Joining the Navy in 19 years, she served at various Naval hospitals in the United States before being sent to the South Pacific. By the end of the war, she was assigned to the Naval air station near Corpus Christi, TX. She ended her Naval career at the Naval hospital in Newport, RI where she met and married her husband John A. Morris. She also began a new career as a supervising nurse for the State of Rhode Island Department of Health, a position she held until her retirement in 1982.
